**Whole-house Ventilation**

- Kitchens, Bathrooms, Attic space, Crawl space & the Basement are the main areas in a home to ventilate.

**Kitchen ventilation:**

- To increase indoor air quality by removing cooking contaminants before they mix with the rest of the air in the house.
- Examples of kitchen pollutants:
  - Heat
  - Steam
  - Smoke
  - Odor
  - Hazardous gases
  - Grease
- Kitchen Solutions:
  - Hood Canopy
    - used to collect & capture cooking vapors
    - should overlap cooking equipment
    - hood should be at correct height in order to capture vapors
    - Types: island hoods, chimney hoods, professional style, built-in hoods, down draft, hideaway, microwave hood combination and conventional
  - Blower system
    - used to controll direction of air flow
    - controls the traffic pattern into the "capture area"
  - Ducting
    - how the polluted air exits the home and into outdoor air

**Bathroom ventilation:**

- The bathroom areas produce a lot of moisture, which can bring mold
- Examples of bathroom damages:
  - Mold
  - Bacteria build up
  - Odor

**Terms**

- Sone - measurement of sound in terms of comfortable hearing levels for an average individual
- HVI - Home Ventilation Institute
- CFM - Cubic Feet Per Minute, used to determine the measurement of air or gas flow into a designated area at a given temperature.
- BTU - British thermal unit, used to raise the temperature of one pound of water one degree Farenheit at a certain temperature.
