#### How long have you been a NKBA Member?

I joined the NKBA Olympic chapter as a "charter" member at the first meeting @ Nilsens Appliances in Silverdale when our chapter was started 5 years ago.

## Give us a little history on how and when you started Creative Countertops.

After working for another fabricating company in N.C. for 8 years I moved out here in 2001 & started making solid surface (Corian) countertops in my garage by myself in 2002. Then I did a lot of "cold calling" on local builders, remodelers, designers & cabinet shops to drum up business. Luckily, I was able to rent my first small 900 sf shop in Suquamish after securing a deal to provide all the countertops for a new 40 unit housing development "Alasund Meadows" in Poulsbo. Then I was able to add a couple of assistants to build & install new countertops. We moved to our current facility in 2007 where we have a 3600 sf shop & added equipment to produce stone & quartz countertops. Then in Dec. 2009 we added our new 1800 sf showroom next door. Currently there are 5 office staff & 7 fabricators/installers that have allowed us to produce a kitchen a day for the last 4 or 5 years.

## What are the different countertop materials you carry/display in your showroom?

We offer the top brand names in Solid Surface, Quartz, Granite & Tile as well as the new recycled products from natural Bamboo, Eco by Cosentino, IceStone & Ecotops. We also have a couple bathroom vignettes, shower surrounds & a fireplace surround that display great tile applications as well as over 20 large sections of floor tile throughout the entire 1800 sf showroom.

I recently went to Brazil and toured the granite quarries & Cosentino's factory where they process the granite blocks into slabs & hand selected a containers worth (42 slabs) of granite in 7 new colors that should arrive in mid-April.

#### What's your favorite feature in your new showroom?

We have had a couple smaller showrooms in the past & the best thing about our new showroom is now we have just about any surface product that any customer could want.

#### Which is your favorite material to work with?

My background is Solid Surface, having fabricating over 3000 kitchens myself since 1993 – so personally I like the Corian & LG HI-MACS. But there are some incredible natural granite colors we have worked with.

#### Anything else you wish to share with your NKBA peers?

I have just returned from the Board of Directors planning meeting in San Antonio & was really impressed with the experience & professionalism of the people there. It sounds like the upcoming K-BIS will be a great show!
