# What inspired you to become a designer in the kitchen & bath industry?

I come from a very artistic family. I was taught to appreciate the differences in life with a passion for the arts. Design let's me express myself and my detail oriented niche; I love the minor details of every project.

# Of your many travels which destinations have helped influence your design style the most?
